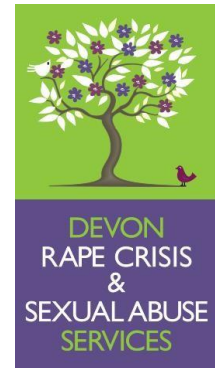


Volunteer Role Description: Friend of Devon Rape Crisis and Sexual Abuse Services (DRCSAS)
